Use gaps between buildings and brownfield sites and build on them instead of sealing new areas.

Greening roofs and façades, unsealing surfaces, implementing a climate adaptation concept.

Affordable and communal

Promote intergenerational, integrative housing projects.

Protect green spaces as the city's habitat and air conditioning system. Introduce tree protection statutes.
